Nyalla is great for mass or specimen planting at roadsides, estates, golf courses, gardens and other amenity areas.

Nyalla - cold hardy, drought hardy, low maintenance, great evergreen foliage, fine leaf, does not produce seed and suits most soil types. It is full sun and shade tolerant. Nyalla is a stylish general garden plant and makes an attractive indoor plant. Its cut foliage makes great fillers for vases, and is well suited for patio pots. Nyalla does well in general coastal conditions and has even survived close to some Perth front line coastal plantings.

Nyalla is a great alternative to a grass tree.

Grass trees are very slow to grow. When people see Nyalla in a garden, they love it. It looks like a beautiful trunkless big grass, but unlike grasses, Nyalla will not need annual trimming and will stay evergreen. Tests show that Nyalla strengthens the soil an impressive 328% - Common Lomandra longifolia only strengthened the soil 50% in the study. CARE	Water as required for 8-13 weeks until established

SOIL TYPE	Sandy, sandy loam to clay soils
